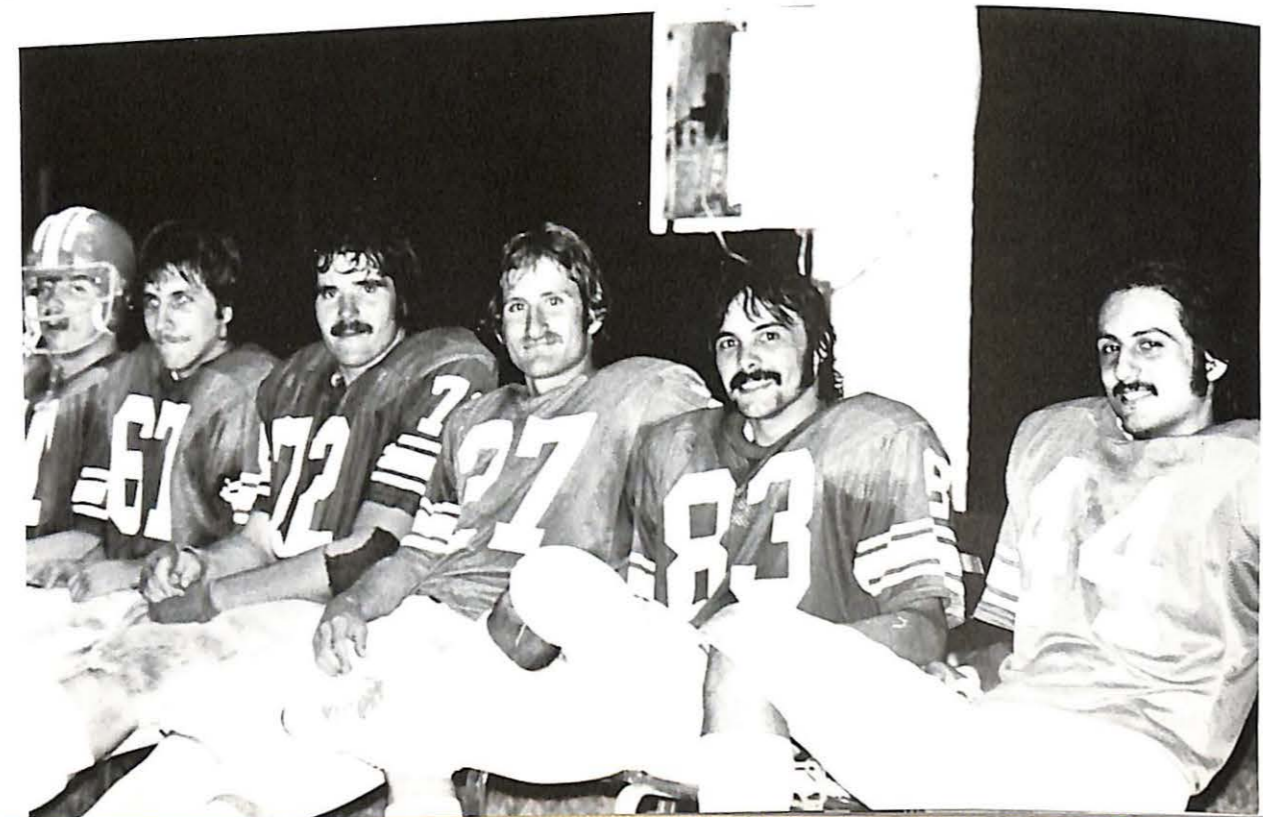
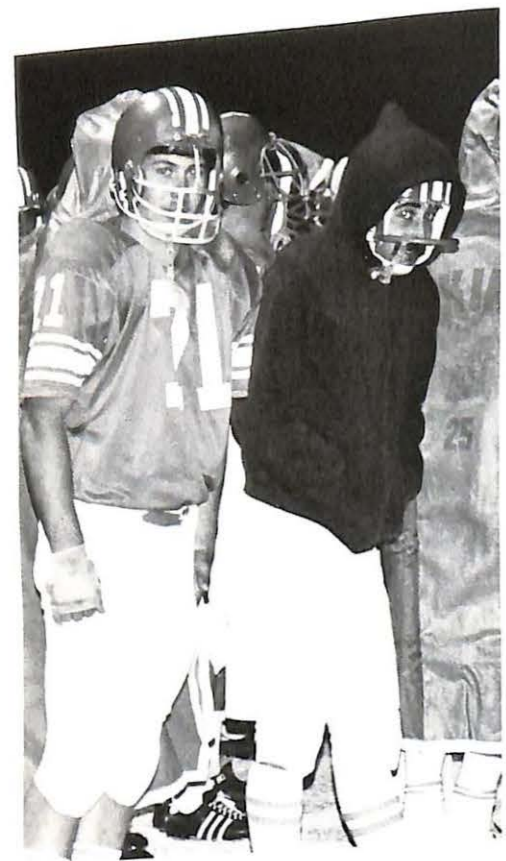


FOOTBALL VIKINGS
