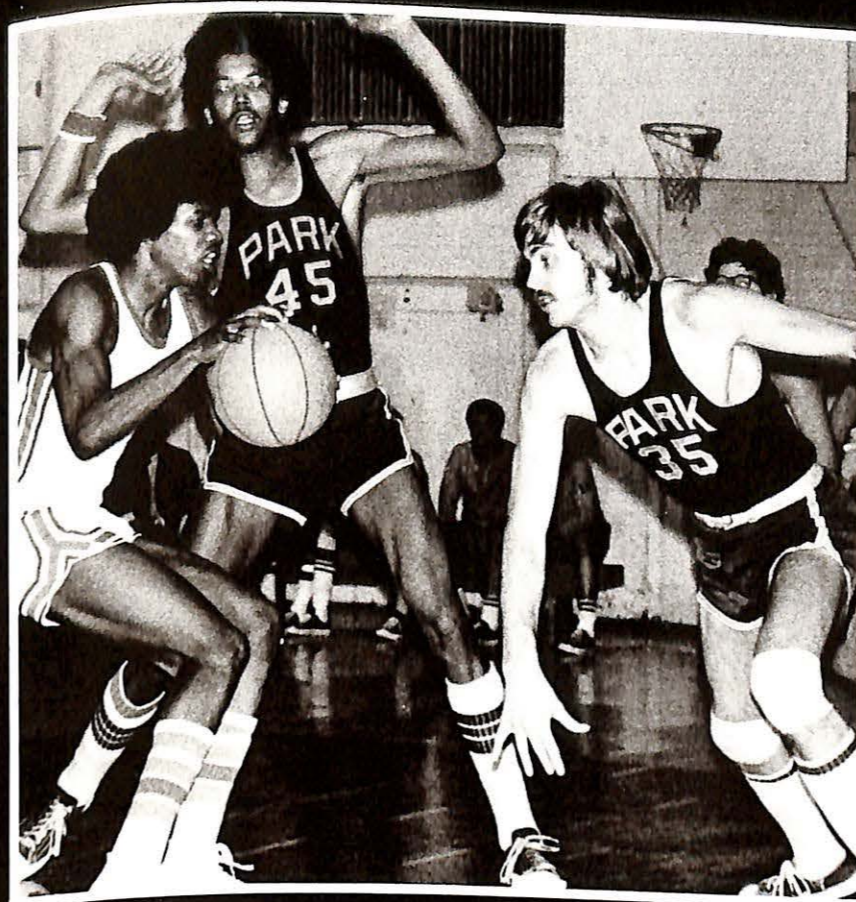
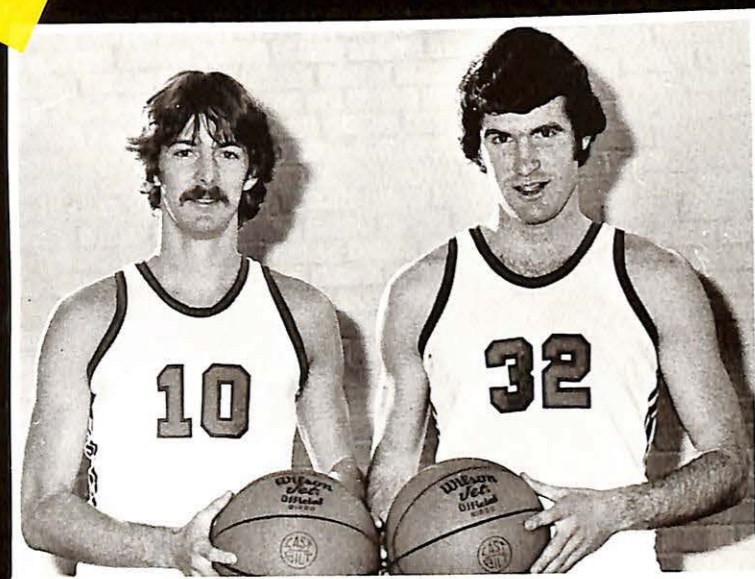
The Missouri Valley Viking gridders had an outstanding record in the 1974 football season, with an overall count of 10-1-1. For the first time since 1971, valleys' football vikings earned their way to play in the Conference Championship game. These rugged vikings have gone farther than any other Heart of America Collegiant Conference team (HACC), with their 37 to 29 victory in Hanover Indiana, a record to be proud of. This win placed them in contengiant for the National Championship Division two game played in Seguin, Texas. The final score of that Missouri Valley verses Texas Lutheran College game was 42 to 0 in favor of T.L.C.



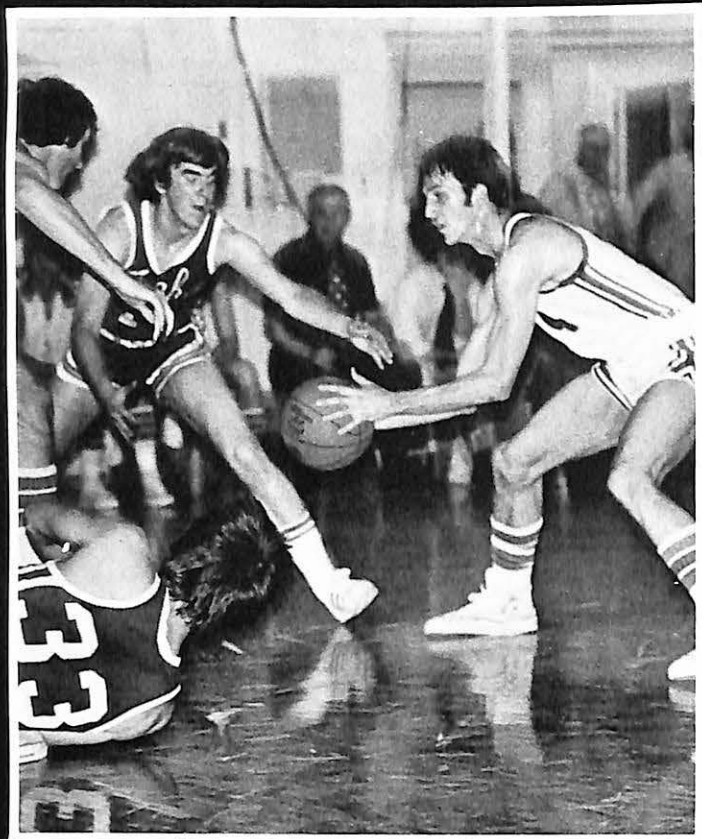
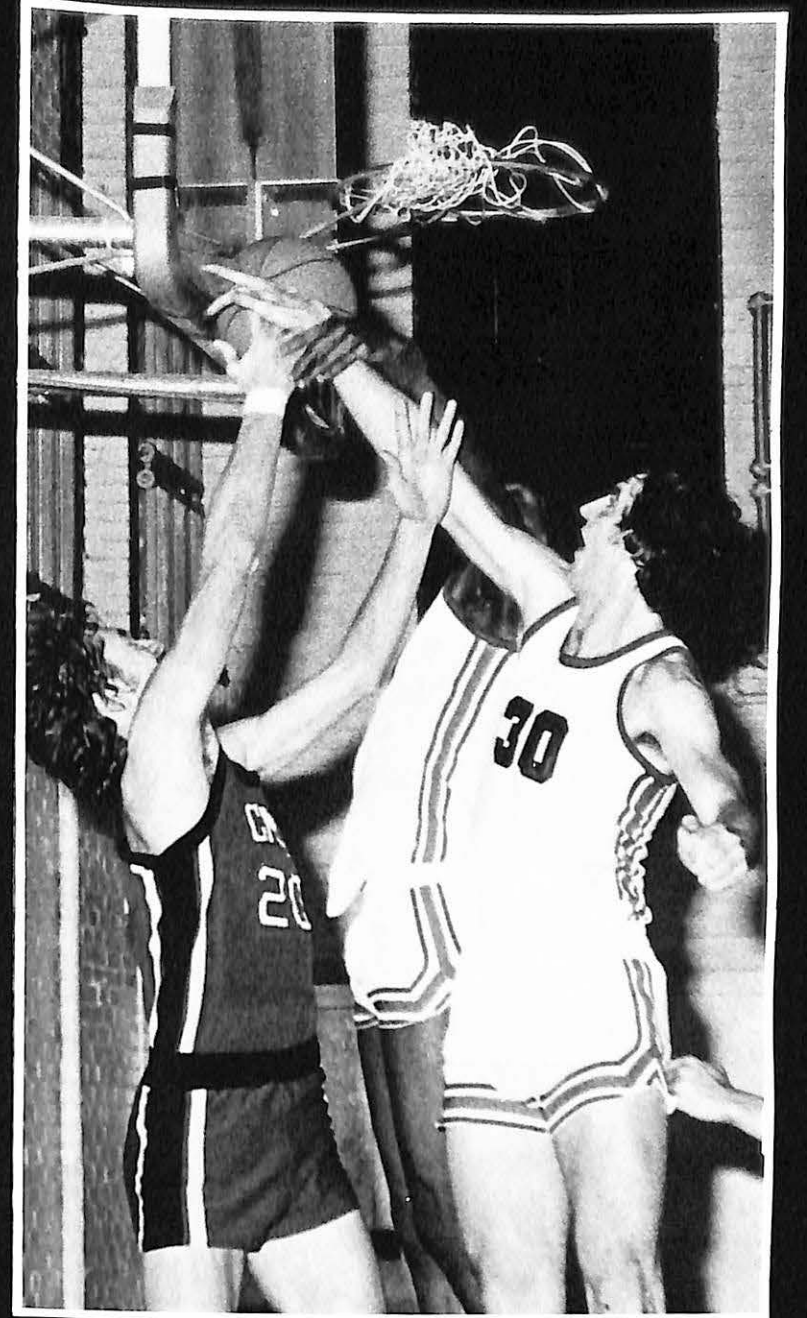
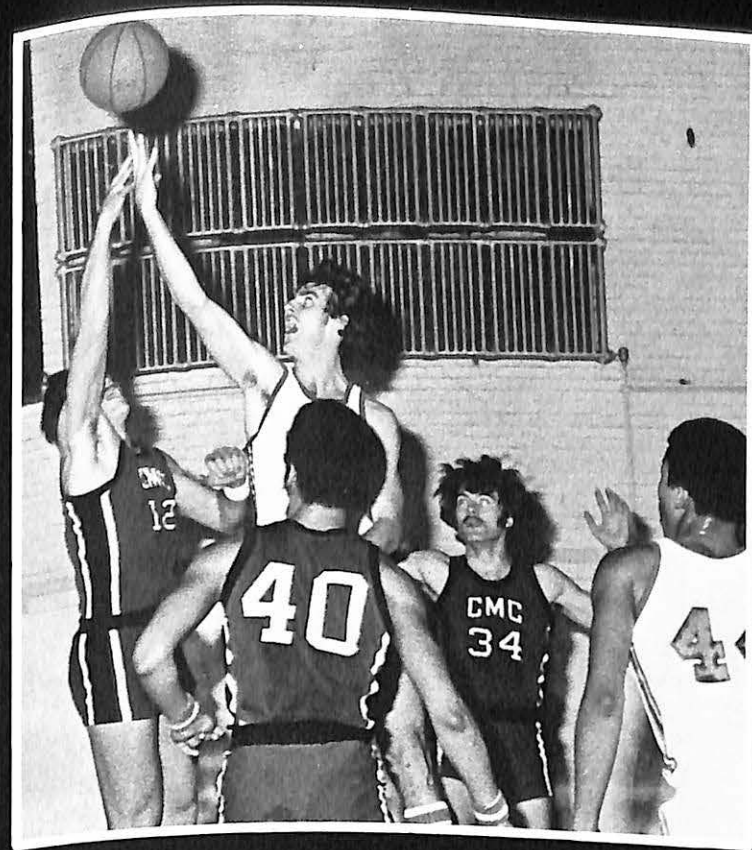
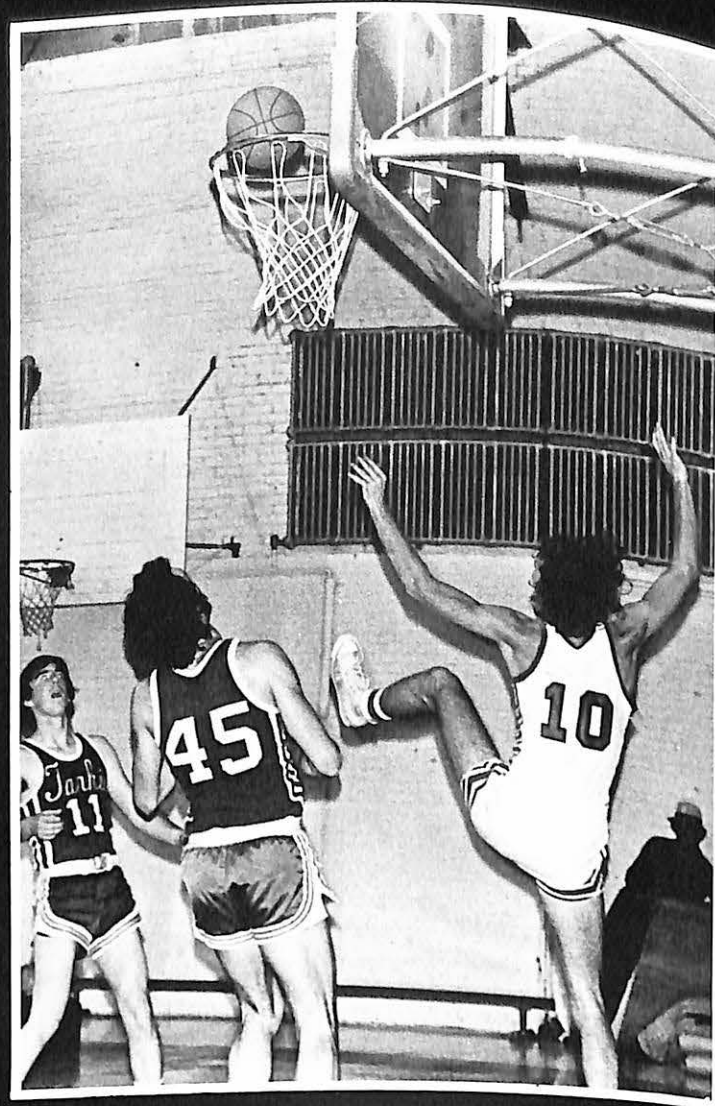
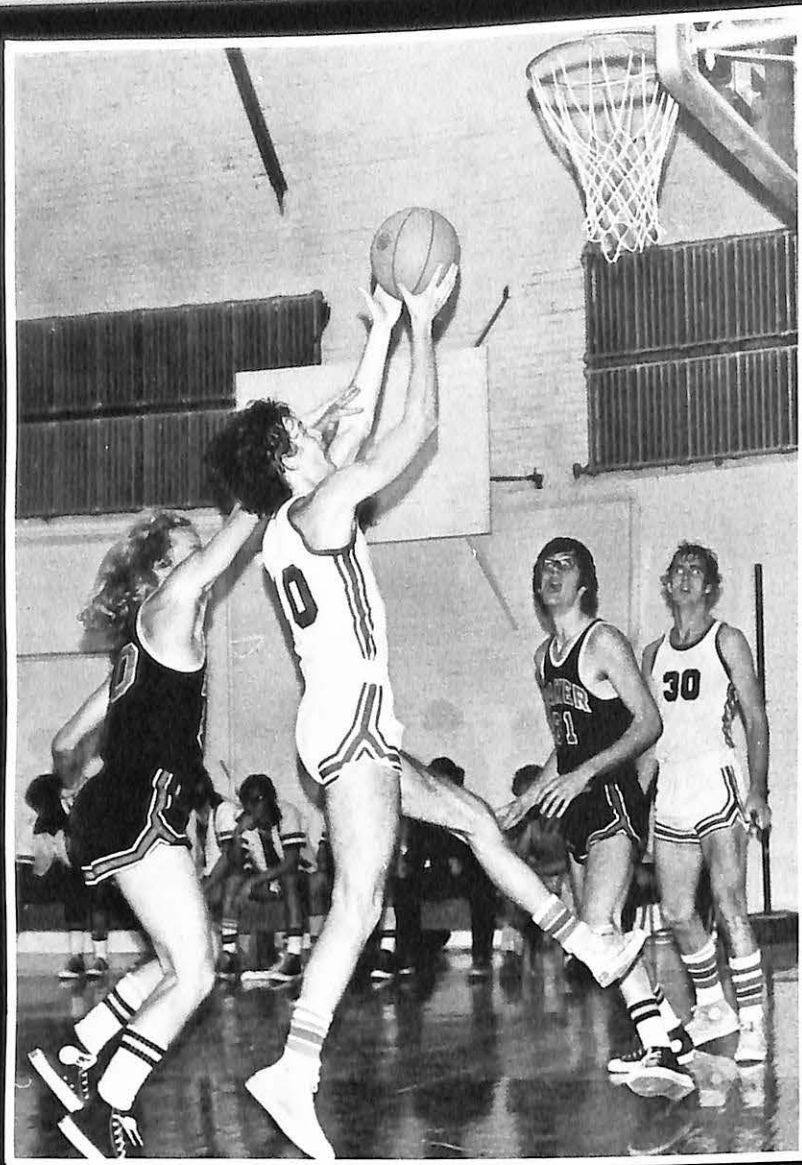
