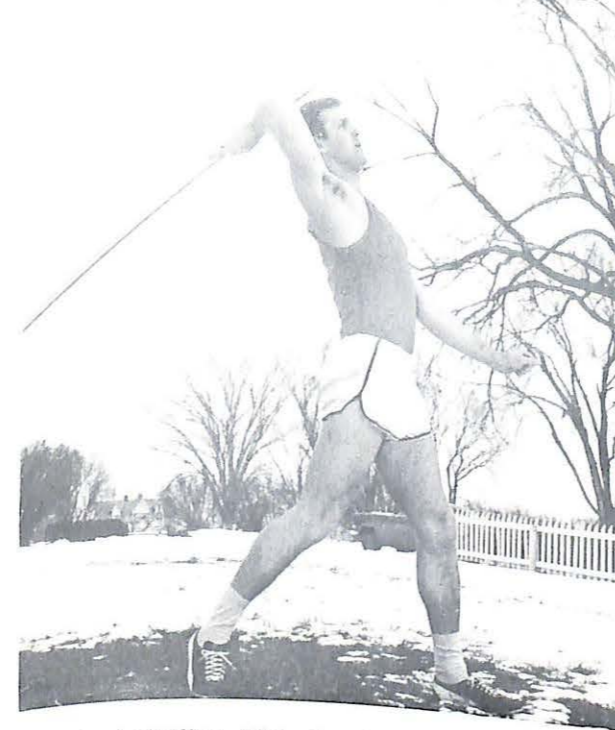
## Track and Field

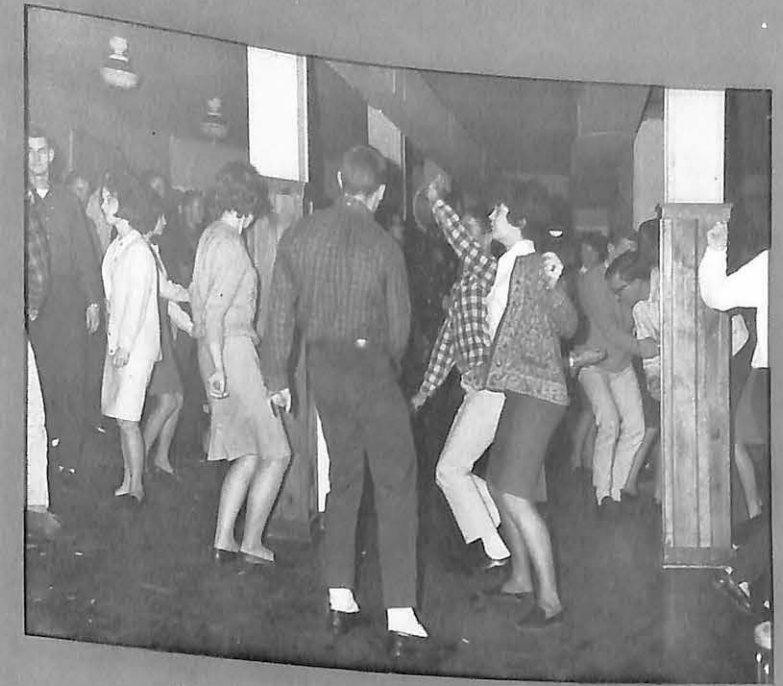
## Women's Intramurals

Girl's Intramurals are conducted in field hockey, volleyball, basketball, softball, and various individual team sports.

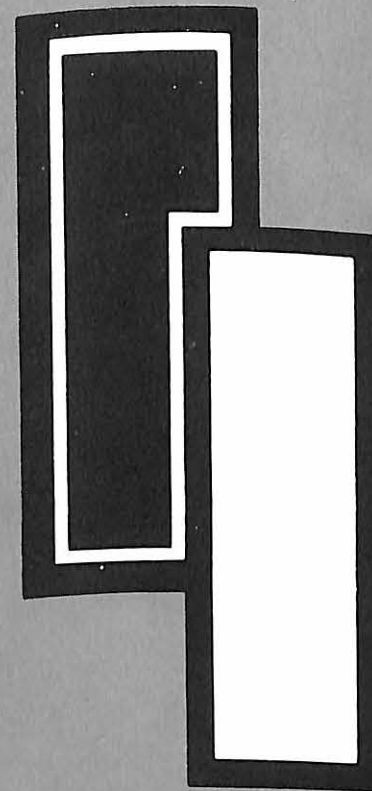

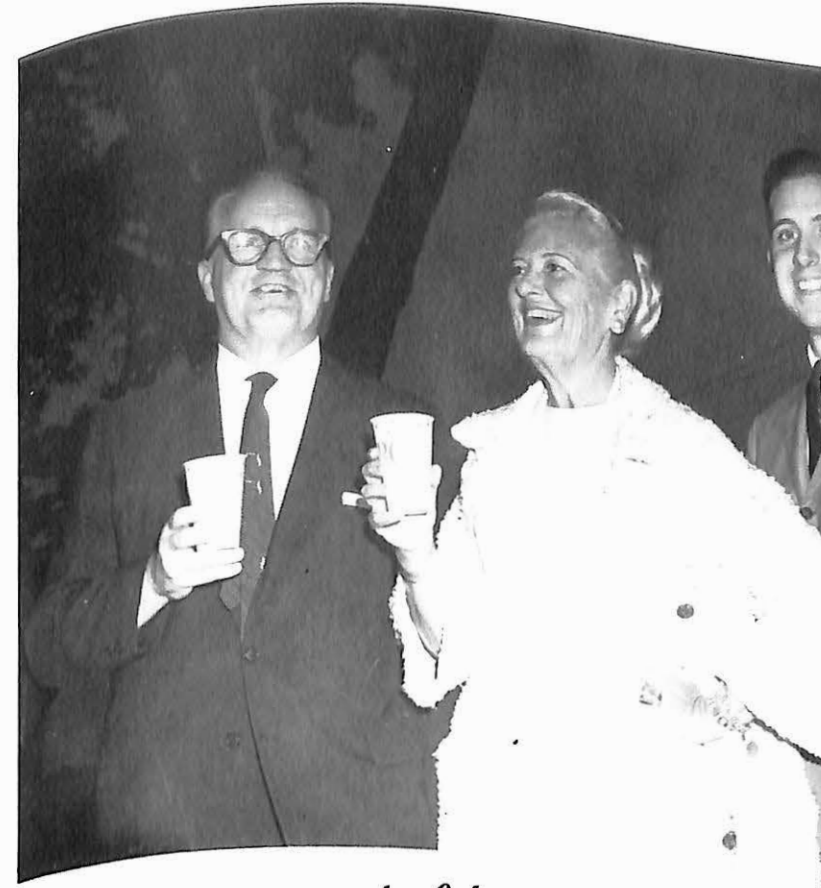

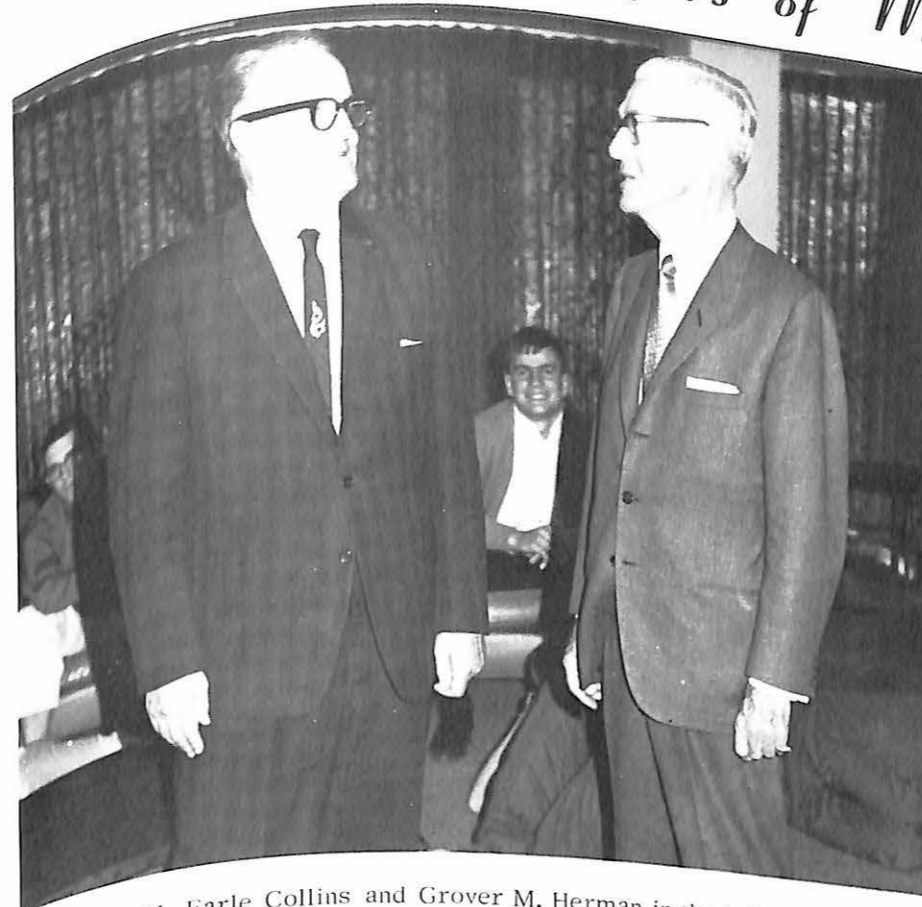
